Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1: Bangalore -Bandipur

Guests arrive at Yeshwantpur Railway Station, by 0845 in morning and you will be briefed and escorted to your respective cabins. Lunch on board.

Deboard at Nanjangud town at 1400hrs. Drive to Bandipur, 50 kms by road.

Evening Safari at Bandipur from 1630 to 1830 hrs. Return to train for dinner and proceed to Mysuru. Train will be stationed overnight at Mysuru.

Day 2: Mysore

After delicious breakfast on board, disembark to visit the famous Mysore Palace and return for lunch. You have option of visiting Srirangapatnam. 4 Overnight stay and dinner onboard the train.

Day 3: Halebidu and Chikamagaluru

Breakfast onboard as train arrives at Banavar Rly Station. Visit Halebidu from Banavar Rly Station at 0800 hrs. Return to train by 1130 hrs. Train proceeds to Chikamagalur. Lunch on board.

Deboard at 1500 hrs to visit plantations followed by coffee tasting and dinner. Return to train.

Day 4: Hampi

After early breakfast onboard, proceed to visit Hampi ruins. Later return back for Lunch onboard. Indian Evening onboard.

Day 5 : Badami

After breakfast on board , optional visit to Badami Caves (climb 200 steps) Later return to the train for lunch. Post lunch deboard to visit Pattadakal and Aihole. Dinner on board.

Day 6 : Goa

After breakfast on board , arrive Goa also known as Tourist Paradise, Goa is the perfect blend of old style architecture and modern India. Proceed to visit Portuguese style architecture and beautiful churches of North Goa and Museum. Lunch on board . Deboard for a Bollywood Evening and dinner at a resort/hotel. Return back to train. Train proceeds to Bengaluru

Day 07: Bangalore Return

Today after breakfast, disembark from the train as this beautiful journey comes to an end.
