Whistler to Vancouver (Three and a half hour journey)

- 2:45 pm to 3:00 pm Motorcoach pick-up in Whistler Village*
- 3:00 pm to 3:30 pm Train boards at Whistler station
- 3:30 pm Train departs Whistler station
- 7:00 pm Train arrives in North Vancouver. Motorcoach transfer to downtown Vancouver
